


GRANTS MANAGEMENT SEMINAR



MR GOPINATH-An Ardent Social Worker & Blood Donor

- "My prime duty is to help the needy"

Vanakkam.

My name is Gopinath. I am 34 years old. I grew up in a very poor family. I completed my schooling in a government school and did a diploma in a private college while helping my father's business. Then began my life in a low-level job in a private company.

While finishing school, I always used to feel that I must do something for those families like ours, who were struggling in life. So, I started doing what I could to help them. I have been doing my best to help those on the roadside with one meal a week, helping a poor child going to school with pens, pencils, and donating food to ashrams, to the extent of my ability.



It was at that time that I happened to meet my school friends Suresh, Yuvraj, Prakash and Kavikumar at a function. Only then did I realize that they were also doing social service like me. From that day on we came together to do this work. As the saying goes, the sound when several hands clapping together is far greater than one hand. Many other kind hearted souls extended help to us. We could do many services with such help.

Then in 2011, following the advice of elders, we registered an organisation under the name "Sri Annai Karangal Nala Sangam", so as to systematically operate these services

Four years later, saddened by witnessing the untimely death of a patient for want of blood in a government hospital, we began to donate as much blood as we could.

Since then, we have worked towards creating awareness of blood donation among the people and today we have about 6000 blood donors all over Tamil Nadu. However, our major services of blood donation are in Coimbatore district.

There are a large number of good people who want to help others, but many don't come forward since they don't know the procedures and sometimes, they have apprehensions of their help reaching the right beneficiary. Due to this many in need of a help are left without help. I appeal to all the kind souls to rise up to the occasion and save lives.

Today I have many responsibilities of looking after my family and children. However, I still feel my prime duty is to help the needy.

Let us extend all possible help to those who are wanting.
